

Line Dance

Finished Size 73 x 87"



Fabric requirements:

40 Jelly Roll strips – 2 ½" strips in a variety of colors or prints (31 are for patchwork and 9 are for binding)

35 Jelly Roll strips – 2 ½" strips for background and side borders OR 2 ¾ yards

¾ yard Accent

1 yard – Outside border

Binding ¾ yard if not using jelly roll strips mentioned above.

5 ¼ yards – Backing

CUTTING:

Colored Jelly Roll Strips

Cut 6 of the strips to 37 ½"

From 25 of the strips cut 2@20"

Put remaining strips aside for binding.

Accent Fabric

Cut 9@2 ½" WOF (width of fabric)

From 2 strips sub-cut 5@10 ½ x 2 ½"

From 2 strips sub-cut 10@6 ½ x 2 ½"

From 5 strips sub-cut 72@2 ½" square

Background

From 6 strips sub-cut 12@20 x 2 ½"

From 10 strips sub-cut 20@18 x 2 ½"

From 10 strips sub-cut 20@16 x 2 ½"

From 5 strips sub-cut 10@14 x 2 ½"

Reserve remaining strips for side borders.

Build your quilt by making rows following the diagram below. In each row press all seam allowances toward the accent fabric. Stitch the rows together and press the seams allowances to one side.

Make a total of 5 strip units.



Make 6 of the row shown below.



Put 4 of these single rows between each of the strip units. Put the remaining 2 rows onto the right side and the left side of the quilt.

Sew background border onto the sides only (not the top and bottom) of the quilt.

Outside border – cut 8@4" WOF. Stitch onto all 4 sides of the quilt.

Quilt as desired.

Binding – stitch the 9 reserved jelly roll strips into one long piece and bind using your desired method.
